#### **Defense Spending** and Impacts in Washington State, Annual Average 2012-2014



- · Defense spending in Washington totalled \$13.5 billion in 2014
  - o \$5 Billion went to Payroll and Operations spending: Military Personnel, Civilian Employees and Non-Contract Expenditures
  - \$8.5 Billion went to Procurements
- · This tool models Procurement spending only, and does not include the \$5 billion spent on expenses and personnel wages at installations
- . The rest of this site presents a three year average of spending and impacts from 2012-2014, expressed in 2014 dollars
